Please read the following information carefully. You and/or your child will be held accountable for the following policies:

**YMCA Expectation of Parents**

The YMCA encourages you as a parent to be a positive force in your child's sport by coming to games, being present at some practices, being aware and empathetic to some of their fears, encouraging your child to do his/her best. And reminding them that winning does not always mean you have to score the most points. Our coaches and staff will help you with this but your child really depends on your encouragement.

**YMCA Expectation of Children**

We expect your child to have fun. We want him/her to participate as a team member, to show good sportsmanship when both winning and losing, and to respect other team members, his/her coach, and themselves. We expect your child to learn new skills and feel good about what they have accomplished.

1. I understand that I am not to leave my child at the YMCA or program site unless a YMCA staff/volunteer is there to receive and supervise my child. This includes the early practice time. If your children come early, they must be accompanied by an adult.
2. I understand that my child will not be allowed to leave the program with an unauthorized person or staff.
3. I understand that any other child not registered in the specific sport or fitness must be accompanied by an adult. While observing any program I will make sure to keep any other child with me from running around.
4. Should I, or another authorized person, arrive to pick up my child with the appearance of being under the influence of alcohol or drugs; I am aware that YMCA staff/volunteer, for the child's safety, may contact the proper authorities.
5. I understand that the YMCA is mandated by state law to report any suspected cases of child abuse or neglect to the appropriate authorities for investigation.
6. I understand that YMCA staff is not allowed to baby-sit or transport children at any time outside of YMCA programs.
7. I understand that my child's photograph may be used for promotional purposes.
8. I understand that participation in the program may be terminated for verbal abuse to any YMCA staff/volunteer by me, my child, or any other accompanying guest. A refund will not be granted for involuntary termination.
9. I understand that YMCA programs focus on skill and character development not competition.
10. I understand that the YMCA Sports & Fitness Program has a "no tolerance" policy. If my child or I deliberately hit/harm another person while in the program will be grounds for immediate dismissal from all programming. I understand it may also affect future registrations in other programs.

**YMCA Basketball Policies:**

1. Cancellations & combination of teams will be done at YMCA Director's discretion.
2. No Full Refunds will be given after the First game.
3. Requests may be honored but are NOT guaranteed. Any requests made after evaluation day will not be honored.
4. Each child MUST attend evaluation day in order for requests to be honored.
