Volunteer Requirements:

- 1. Volunteer Application:** After you have completed and signed the volunteer application, please return the application in person, by mail or by fax to the Anaheim Family YMCA.
- 2. Fingerprints:** All volunteers, regardless of age, must be fingerprinted. Please take the live scan form (provided by the YMCA) to the **Fullerton Police Department**. An appointment is needed, so please call (714) 738-6800.
****A \$20 reimbursement is available upon request with a receipt and copy of the completed live scan form.****
- 3. Tuberculosis Test (TB):** If tested within the past 2 years, please submit proof, such as a medical record, in order to be cleared from this process. Otherwise, please go to the Amistad Medical Clinic for a free test (form provided by YMCA.) An appointment is needed, so please call 714-758-1695.
- 4. Volunteer Orientation/Training:** All volunteers are required to attend a volunteer orientation/training to learn the policies/procedures of the YMCA, tips for working with children, program specific information, etc. *Orientation/Training will be set individually depending on Program Department you will be completing your volunteer work.*

Administration/Special Events

Hours: YMCA Administration office hours are Mon-Fri. 8am-6:30pm; Special Events hours vary

Enrichment & Special Projects: Participate in special projects by bringing your own skills, wisdom and expertise to a small group of students. Special project activities include teaching a craft, presenting on a special topic of your choice or demonstrating a skill.

Hours: Summer Season-Hours vary Mon-Fri 9am-7pm

Class Instructor Assistant: Help assist swim instructors with classes by demonstrating skills and/or monitoring participants. Assure the safety of all participants while making the class fun and enjoyable. *Minimum Age Requirement: 14 years old*

☐ Sports & Fitness

Hours: Varies Mon.-Fri 4pm-9pm; Sat & Sun hours vary

Basketball Coach/Asst. Coach: Teach kids ages 3-17 the fundamentals of basketball as well the 4 pillars of character (respect, honesty, caring, and responsibility). One hour a week for practice and 2 hours on weekends for games.

Referee: Volunteer to officiating basketball games on the weekends. You can choose from 5 different age groups (5-6, 7-8, 9-11,12-14, & 15-17). *Minimum Age Requirement: 16 years old*

Team Parent: Get involved with your child's team. Assist the Sports coaches with organizing the snack schedules, fundraisers, & pictures.

Scorekeeper: Keep score and stats for weekend sport games. *Minimum Age Requirement: No age restrictions*

Class Instructor Assistant: Help assist sports & fitness instructors with classes by demonstrating skills and/or monitoring participants. Assure the safety of all participants while making the class fun and enjoyable. *Minimum Age Requirement:14 years old*

☐ Camps

Hours: Camp FOX, 6/23-6/29; Camp MIEHANA, 7/27-8/3

Leader: To assure a high quality outdoor experience and the implementation of a safe and intentional camp environment; to offer an important and unique chance to cultivate and enjoy leadership skills, a variety of enrichment opportunities and character development; to foster companionship and understanding while setting a foundation for positive, lifelong relationships between campers, leaders and staff; upholds the rules, policies, and traditions of the camp to the camper; along with cabin leader, serves as a good role model and example to campers in personal language, appearance, manners and healthy habits; and, expands an awareness of spirit, mind and body. *Minimum Age Requirement: Camp FOX – 21 years old; Camp MIEHANA – 18 years old*

Counselor in Training (CIT): Lives in a cabin with cabin leader and a total of 10 campers; assists cabin leader with leadership and guidance of campers in daily living skills, with special attention to – safety, camper participation in all activities, camper personal growth, self-confidence and independence through group living; actively participates in camp activities including games, skits, activities and campfires; upholds the rules, policies, and traditions of the camp to the camper; along with cabin leader, serves as a good role model and example to campers in personal language, appearance, manners and healthy habits. *Minimum Age Requirement: Camp MIEHANA– 16 years old*

Junior Leader in Training (JLT): JLTs are subject to the same code of behavior and policies as program staff & leaders and will participate in all aspects of camp, under the supervision of the JLT coordinator. They will help with devising and planning games and activities, help supervise during camp programming, participate in informal and formal activities with campers, work with staff to develop and co-lead workshops or games, and help provide a safe and supportive atmosphere for campers. JLTs will always work with a Counselor and/or the JLT Director and never be alone with a camper, and work with the JLT Director to learn the basics of child development, programming, and supervision policies and procedures. *Minimum Age Requirement: Camp MIEHANA– 14 years old*

Applicant Statement

Photo Release

Fieldtrip Release

I have made a voluntary request to participate in fieldtrips in conjunction with the Anaheim Family YMCA. I am aware that any fieldtrip that I volunteer for may present a risk of injury and agree to assume all risks for injuries arising out of my participation as a volunteer. I agree that the Anaheim Family YMCA and all its employees, officials, agents, representatives, or partners shall NOT be responsible or liable for any injury, damage loss or expense, to my person and/or my property, incurred while participating in an Anaheim Family YMCA fieldtrip.

Clear Criminal Record Testament

I attest that I have no criminal record meaning I have never had any misdemeanor or felony charges brought against me and I have never been convicted of any crime other than a minor traffic offense.

Fingerprinting Authorization for Minors

It is the policy of the Anaheim Family YMCA that all employees and volunteers must be fingerprinted and cleared by the California Department of Justice (DOJ) and the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), and the Child Abuse Index (CAI) for licensed facilities. Since the nature of our business is working with or around youth, fingerprinting is one of the ways we can help ensure their safety in our programs.

Volunteer Driving Acknowledgment

The Anaheim Family YMCA does not ask any of our volunteers to ever transport any of our program participants to/from any YMCA activity/program.

As a volunteer/coach/mentor of the Anaheim Family YMCA, I will be driving to where the activity/game takes place. I attest that I have a valid driver's license, appropriate automobile insurance coverage as required by CA law, and have an acceptable driving record.

If the volunteer application is a minor, under the age of 18, parental authorization is required prior to being fingerprinted.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY
AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT**

IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to utilize the facilities, services and programs of the YMCA for any purpose, including, but not limited to observation or use of facilities or equipment, or participation in any off-site program affiliated with the YMCA, the undersigned, for himself or herself and any personal representatives, heirs, and next of kin, hereby acknowledges, agrees and represents that he or she has, or immediately upon entering or participating will, inspect and carefully consider such premises and facilities or the affiliated program. It is further warranted that such entry into the YMCA for observation or use of any facilities or equipment or participation in such affiliated program constitutes an acknowledgement that such premises and all facilities and equipment thereon and such affiliated program have been inspected and carefully considered and that the undersigned finds and accepts same as being safe and reasonably suited for the purpose of such observation, use or participation.

IN FURTHER CONSIDERATION OF BEING PERMITTED TO ENTER THE YMCA FOR ANY PURPOSE INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO OBSERVATION OR USE OF FACILITIES OR EQUIPMENT, OR PARTICIPATION IN ANY OFF-SITE PROGRAM AFFILIATED WITH THE YMCA, THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY RELEASES, WAIVES, DISCHARGES AND CONVENANTS NOT TO SUE the YMCA, its directors, officers, employees, and agents (hereinafter referred to as "releases") from all liability to the undersigned, his personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefore on account of injury to the person or property or resulting in death of the undersigned, whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise while the undersigned is in, upon, or about the premises or any facilities or equipment therein or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA.
2. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY AGREES TO INDEMNIFY AND SAVE AND HOLD HARMLESS the releases and each of them from any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur due to the presence of the undersigned in, upon or about the YMCA premises or in any way observing or using any facilities or equipment of the YMCA or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA whether caused by the negligence of the releases or otherwise.
3. THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY ASSUMES FULL RESPONSIBILITY FOR AND RISK OF BODILY INJURY, DEATH OR PROPERTY DAMAGE due to negligence of release or otherwise while in, about or upon the premises of the YMCA and/or while using the premises or any facilities or equipment thereon or participating in any program affiliated with the YMCA.

THE UNDERSIGNED further expressly agrees that the foregoing RELEASE, WAIVER AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

THE UNDERSIGNED HAS READ AND VOLUNTARILY SIGNS THE RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, and further agrees that no oral representations, statements or inducement apart from the foregoing written agreement have been made.
