Terms and Conditions for Use of Premises Agreement

- (1) Party shall leave the facilities/premises in a clean and orderly condition; if any alterations were allowed, restore the facilities to original condition, and shall repair any damage caused by its negligence or neglect or that of its representative or invitees.
- (2) Party defends, indemnifies and holds harmless the Anaheim Family YMCA, its directors, officers, agent, representatives and employees (and its affiliated corporations) from all liability, loss or damage whatever from any cause which may arise from the use of the facilities/premises or activities in and about the same by participants, guests or invitees.
- (3) YMCA liability waiver must be signed by all participants / parents of children
- (4) YMCA may terminate this agreement, and permission to use such facilities/premises, at any time for good cause without obligation except to refund the amount which Organization has donated
- (5) All participants who enter the water must abide by the swim attire policy (see below)

Approved Swim Attire

Suitable attire for **men**:

- o Men must wear swim trunks with a liner and a drawstring or a Speedo with a drawstring
- o Men may not wear jean cut-offs, bike shorts, basketball shorts or street shorts
- o Men may not wear t-shirts of any kind- due to safety concerns
 - Rash guards may be worn- form fitting lycra or nylon shirt

Suitable attire for **women**:

- o Women must wear swimming suit; either one piece or two piece style
- o Women may not wear undergarments including sports bra, bra, underwear
- o Women may not wear jean cut-offs, bike shorts, basketball shorts, leotards, or street clothes
- o Women are permitted to wear swim trunks that meet the men's guidelines over a suitable women's bathing suit
- o Women may not wear t-shirts of any kind- due to safety concerns
 - Rash guards may be worn- form fitting lycra or nylon shirt

All members including children are expected to be in compliance with all swim attire guidelines.

Personal items not permitted in the pool:

- o Street clothes and shoes
- o Floating devices (including: arm floats, float rings, rafts, bathing suits with floatation devices sewn in, or non-coast guard approved life jackets)

Members that are not going to enter the swim area do not need to wear swim attire

- o Adults who are supervising children under the age of 7 must wear proper swim attire and accompany the children into the water and must remain within arm's reach of the child

The swim staff reserves the right to inspect members for proper swim attire prior to entrance and while inside the facility.
